Please read the following Reading Community Education Drivers Education policies and then sign at the bottom.

As a student of the Reading Community Education Driver's Education program, I agree to and understand the following rules:

- My age at the time of this registration is 15 years, 9 months or older
- Full payment is expected at the time of registration in the amount of \$710
- If after the parent meeting you decide to not be part of the program you will get 100% refund, otherwise we offer a 90% refund up to two full business days before the class begins. Once the class begins we do not give a refund unless it is medically related.
- I must complete 30 hours of classroom instruction, 12 hours of behind-the-wheel driving instruction, 6 hours observation and additional 40 hours of supervised road time with a parent or guardian in order to be eligible to receive a Driver Education Certificate of Completion from the RMV.
- If I miss a class for any reason, I must make-up the missed class. If I do not attend the make-up class for each and every missed class, I will be ineligible to pass the course. Two or more classes missed might be subject to a \$100 penalty fee.
- Tardiness and/or early departure from any class will count as an absence.
- The instructor has the authority to drop any student from the program who is disruptive. The student will be ineligible to receive a refund.
- There will be a charge of \$60 for each on road lesson that is missed without a 24 hour notice.

Fees (in addition to cost of class) paid to the RMV:

Permit Fee \$30: This will be paid to the RMV the day of the permit exam

License Fee \$85: This includes the road test and license fee

Driver Education Certificate \$15: This will be paid when all components of the Driver Education Program are complete. Once complete, the check should be made payable to MASSDOT and sent to the Reading Community Education Office to be submitted to the RMV.

RMHS Drivers Education Sponsored Road Test at RMV

The Reading Community Education Drivers Education Program is now offering Sponsored Road Tests at the Wilmington RMV branch. This service is only for students who have completed our program. This fee includes pick up and drop off to the RMV in the Driver Education car, practice time before the test and one of our instructors as the student's sponsor. The RMHS sponsor fee is \$95.00. Students are responsible for scheduling and paying any of their Registry fees. The RMHS ROAD TEST \$95.00 FEE must be paid by check made payable to the TOWN OF READING and mailed to the Reading Memorial High School Driver's Education Program, 62 Oakland Road, Reading, MA 01867 prior to the Road Test and students must coordinate the date with us via email as soon as the date is scheduled with the RMV.

Please note that our instructors are unable to sponsor students during school hours when school is in session. RMHS students should not be dismissed from school for Road Tests. Please schedule Road Tests after 4pm on weekdays when school is in session.

If you have graduated already or it is the summer, please let us know. You will be able to schedule your Road Test any time on a weekday!

RMHS sponsored Road Tests must be scheduled and coordinated with our office in advance and can only be scheduled on certain days and times.
